



WHO'S WHO?

Kamp Director

Oversee's all of Kamp, ensuring a smooth and Christ-centered experience for all participants

Kamp Pastor

Provides spiritual leadership, delivers messages, and guides kampers in their faith journey at kamp

TC Coordinator

Oversees team captains, preparing and assisting them in their duties throughout Kamp

Kamp Coordinator

Responsible for organizing and overseeing all aspects of Kamp operations

Nurse

Provides medical care and handles all kamper medications and health concerns

Recreation Lead

Oversees all Kamp recreational activities, ensuring safety and fun

Music Lead

Guides kampers in music-related activities, worship, and performances

Arts & Crafts Teacher

Facilitates creative activities and hands-on projects for kampers

Teacher

Leads biblical lessons, teaching kampers the Word of God

Adult Counselor

Assists with Kamp operations, providing support and guidance to kampers

Team Captain

Youth counselors (ages 14-18) who are with kampers 24/7, serving as role models and mentors, fostering a big-brother, big-sister relationship with them

TEAMS



The Value of TEAMS

TEAMS enhance Kamp by fostering community, friendship, and confidence. Through chants, challenges, and shared goals, kids develop a sense of belonging and identity, bond with peers, support one another, and learn sportsmanship.



New Team Selection Process

This year, a new selection system for first-year campers will be introduced. During the Kamp Rally on Day 1, new campers will be randomly assigned to one of four teams via a fun stage presentation. Their names will be displayed on a screen, and current team members will cheer as they come down and join their new team. Once assigned, campers will stay on the same team for future years, fostering deeper connections and team pride.



TEAM CAPTAIN

Who are Team Captains?

Team Captains are selected high school students (grades 9-12) who act as youth leaders during the Kamp experience. They possess leadership qualities and positive attitudes, helping to create a welcoming, safe environment for kampers to grow, have fun, and feel supported.

What do Team Captains do?

Team Captains support staff by leading activities, encouraging kampers during competitions, and aiding daily routines. They build relationships, motivate kids, and set a positive tone with their energy. Most importantly, they exemplify Christ-like character, guiding kampers with love, patience, and encouragement.



KAMP 101



Meals

- Breakfast, Lunch, and Dinner will be provided on Days 1-3.
- Breakfast and Lunch will be provided on Day 4.

Activities

- No one is allowed at any activity (canoes, archery, zip-line, swimming, etc.) without CKK Staff supervision.
- All recreational and free activities must be supervised by a Team Captain or an Adult CKK staff member.





Swimming & Water Activities

- ALL CKK staff must supervise any water-related activities, along with Campsite Staff.
- Life jackets must be worn for any lake activities.
- A swim test will be administered for any pool area deeper than five feet.
- Female Swimsuit Policy: One-piece swimsuits are required. Two-piece swimsuits may be worn only if covered by a non-see-through t-shirt.
- Male Swimsuit Policy: Swim trunks must be longer than fingertip length.
